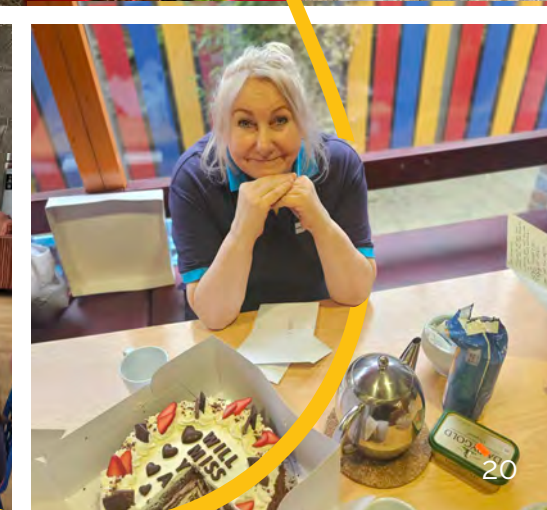

1974
The first Ronald McDonald House opened in Philadelphia, USA.

1997
Ronald McDonald House Charities is set up in Ireland.

2004
We opened the first Irish Ronald McDonald House at Our Lady's Children's Hospital, Crumlin.

2010
We extended our facilities by opening a four-bedroom House in St Mary's Drive. We now provide 20 families every night with accommodation, care and support. Our annual running costs are €500,000.

2013
We launched our fundraising campaign (Gathering Ball) to build a New Ronald McDonald House alongside the New Children's Hospital.

2014
We celebrated 10 years of caring for families from all over Ireland.

2015
We designed a 52 bedroom Ronald McDonald House and submitted plans to An Bord Pleanála alongside plans for the New Children's Hospital.

2016
Planning permission was granted for a New Children's Hospital and a new Ronald McDonald House.

2017
RMHC Wear Your Stripes event launched by Taoiseach Leo Varadkar and Minister for Health Simon Harris.

2019
We continued to work on signing a contract with the HSE and raised funds for the current and the new House.

2019
We celebrated 15 years of taking care of families.

2020
We kept our House open and safe for all our families during the Covid-19 pandemic.

2022
The design of our New 52 bedroom House was completed this year.

2021
Minister of Health announces appointment of RMHC Ireland as accommodation provider for The New Children's Hospital.

2023
We won The Charities Institute "People's Choice Fundraising Team of the Year" award.

2024
We completed the final pour on our new House with some very special guests.

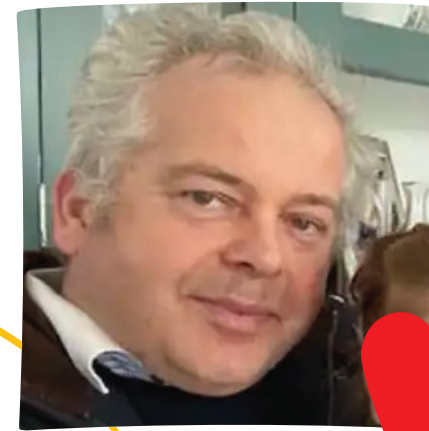

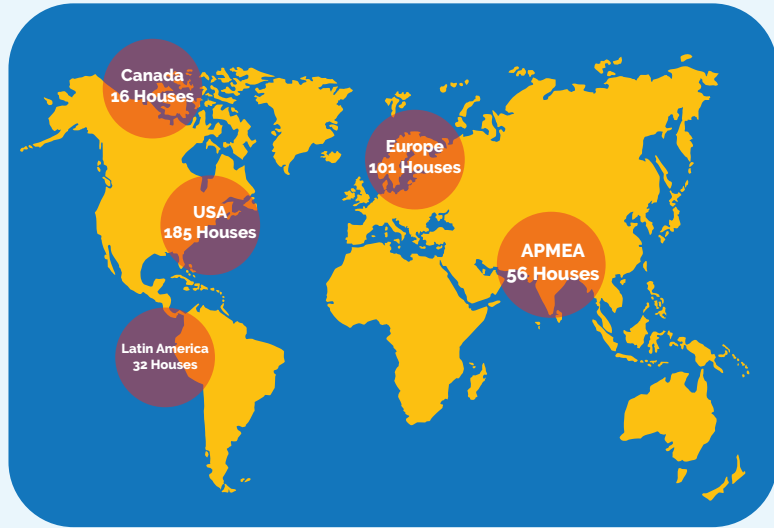

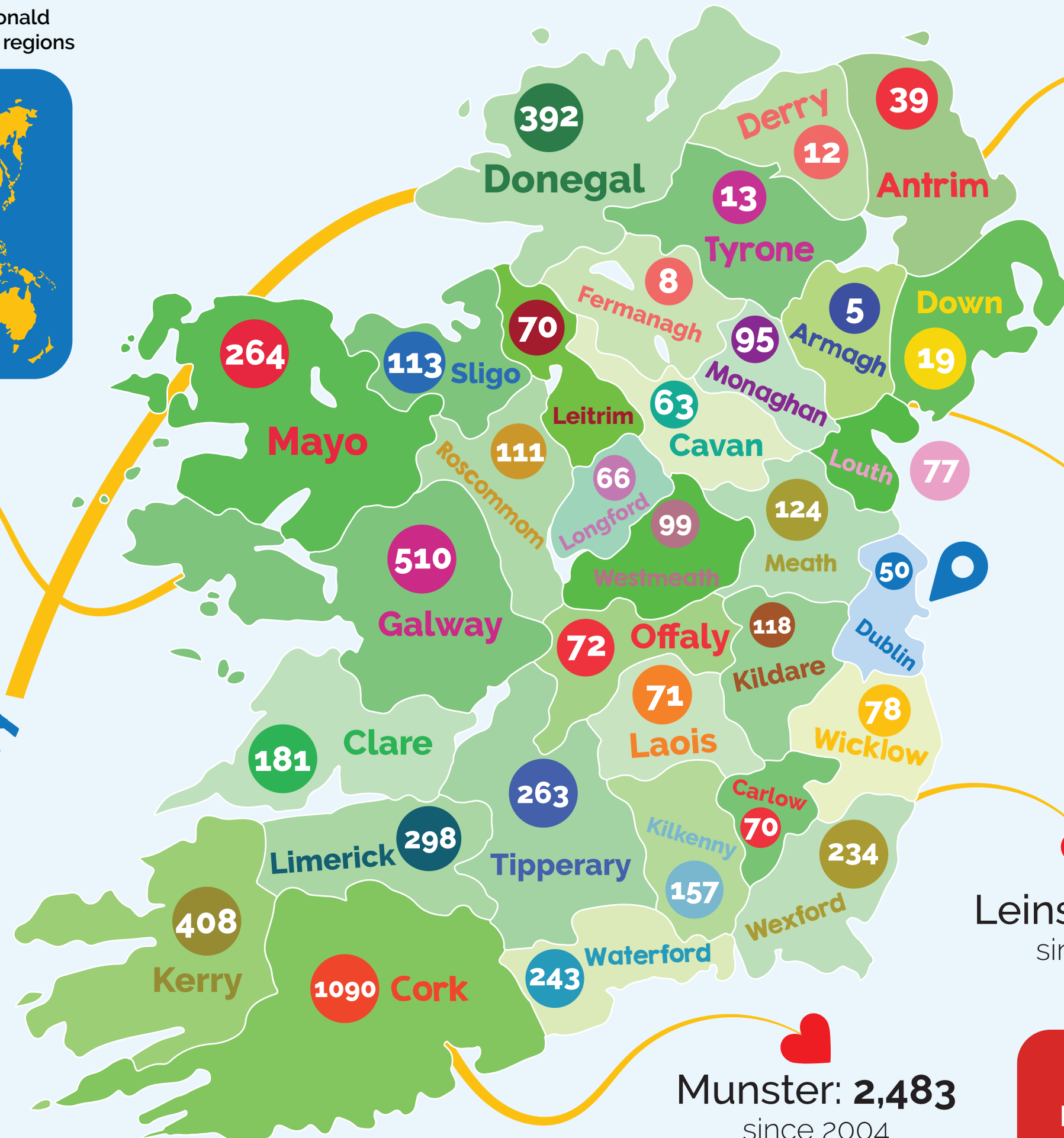

House Day Pass

care that continues....

This year we introduced a Day Pass scheme at the House and it has quickly become a success. Families who once stayed in the house during some of their most challenging moments can now return for a Day Pass when attending hospital appointments with their child, offering them comfort, familiarity, and a place to rest between visits.

It means that even after leaving, they remain part of the house community, able to make a cup of tea, share a quiet moment, and find reassurance in surroundings that once supported them so fully.

In 2025 **323 Day Passes** were issued to Families and for the Rooney- Slowey family from Co. Monaghan it has been invaluable.

"Cara has frequent appointments in Crumlin and as we are coming up from Monaghan we are very lucky to be able to make use of the Day Pass.

It's such a brilliant asset that has been added to the house. The difference it makes to a visit to hospital is invaluable.

From the panic of getting out of your house in the morning to getting back home after appointments we know all too well how long, non stop and tiring hospital days are...

The house gives us relief, a base, somewhere to decompress between appointments and that long journey home. A safe familiar place to bring and feed Cara.

A place for us to refuel, sit and have a tea or coffee. Its a place where we can distract ourselves when she's under general anaesthetic. A home from home, a comforting meal, a friendly chat and a warm hug are always waiting for us".

Treasurer's Message

Dear Supporters and Stakeholders,

As the Treasurer of Ronald McDonald House Charities, I am delighted to present a summary of our financial results for the fiscal year 2025. Your unwavering commitment to our cause has enabled us to make significant progress toward our mission, and I am pleased to share our financial highlights with you.

Revenue: Our total revenue for the year amounted to **€3,618,664**, encompassing donations, grants, program fees and in kind Donations. Your generosity has been crucial in allowing us to continue supporting families at our House in Crumlin while also funding our New Ronald McDonald House in Rialto. We also received **€267,483** in Investment Income for 2025.

Expenses: We allocated funds prudently to support our core activities. Major expense categories included program development, administrative costs, and outreach efforts.

New Ronald McDonald House: Capital donations for the New House in 2025 totalled **€556,800**. The total sponsorship funds designated for the new House stood at **€4,837,043** as of December 31, 2025. This has now been fully used on construction costs of New Ronald McDonald House on St James's Hospital Campus in Rialto.

Transparency: Ronald McDonald House Charities Ireland is committed to efficiency, transparency, and accountability to ensure the funds we receive benefit the families we serve.
